Dear Mr. Dunagan:

I refer to our letter dated February 12, 2015, regarding the release of certain Department of State records under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552.

A number of documents were referred to other government offices for inter- or intra-agency coordination for further review to assist us in making a final determination regarding their release under FOIA. The inter- and intra-agency coordination for 42 of these documents has been completed. We have determined that 1 of these 42 documents is non-responsive to the request, 22 must be withheld in part, 19 must be withheld in full pursuant to FOIA exemption 1 and 5, 5 U.S.C. §§ 552 (b)(1) and (b)(5).

Where we have made excisions, the applicable FOIA exemptions are marked on each document. In some cases, two or more exemptions may apply to the same document. An enclosure explains Freedom of Information Act exemptions and other grounds for withholding material.
